Required Items

✓ Equestrian Specific Items

- ☐ ASTM/SEI approved helmet. We recommend a helmet with MiPS system (please reach out for more info if needed). If your helmet has been involved in a serious fall, please purchase a new one. All helmets must also be manufactured in the last five years and fit will be checked upon arrival to camp.
- ☐ Boots- Tall or Paddock are acceptable. However, Paddock boots are cooler while doing unmounted and horsemanship lessons (half chaps are also permitted)
- ☐ 3 to 4 pairs of breeches or jodhpurs (laundry is done once during the session and these will NOT be dried in a dryer)
- ☐ Riding shirts (waistline or able to be tucked in)
- ☐ 2 Shirts with KEA logo (any style)
- ☐ Belt (for breeches with belt loops)
- ☐ Riding socks (comfortable with your riding boots)
- ☐ Riding raincoat (waterproof is necessary)
- ☐ *Riding crop
- ☐ *Riding gloves to prevent blisters

ALL ITEMS BROUGHT TO CAMP MUST BE CLEARLY LABELED WITH CAMPER'S NAME.

LINENS ARE PROVIDED

Sheets, blankets, and towels are provided as part of our all-inclusive tuition. You are welcome to pack these items, but they are not required.



Specifically, we provide a set of sheets, one camp style wool blanket and one fleece blanket. Two different sizes of towels are provided, specifically for waterfront usage and for showers. Please note that while our towels and linens are clean and in good condition, they are not necessarily luxurious and may not feel the same as items you use at home. For this reason, along with wanting to personalize their space, many campers like to bring a comforter or extra blanket, and at least one beach towel. Some people choose to bring their own linens completely; however this is not necessary or required.

DRESS UP CLOTHING

Examples include – bandanas and/or Western style shirt and hat; neon clothing, tutus, capes, fun glasses and hats, boas; 4th of July accessories, etc. Please don't feel the need to make a special shopping trip but if you have dress-up items at home and have space in your bags it is worth throwing them in. There are many opportunities to dress up at camp!



MISCELLANEOUS

Popular items include foam mattress topper or egg crate, Crazy Creek or camp style chair; and embroidery floss for friendship bracelets. Campers often bring journals and a book to read during down time.

LOST/LEFT BEHIND ITEMS

Despite our best efforts, inevitably items are misplaced or left behind when the session ends. We will make every effort to return all labeled items to each camper at the close of camp. If we find an item belonging to your camper, we will contact you via email ASAP.

You will then have the choice to:

- Have it sent back to you via the Mailing Center (shipping fees apply).
- Have it donated.

UNIFORM AND DRESS CODE

We do not have a required uniform at Kippewa Equestrian Academy. However, we ask that your camper **bring two KEA logo shirts**. Many campers also like to have additional KEA branded items such as long sleeve shirts and pants.



Campers may wear non-designer clothing. Simple brand logos such as Nike, Adidas, Gap, etc. are okay. High-end designer labels are inappropriate for camp. Camp clothing should be comfortable and functional. Kippewa Equestrian Academy is not responsible for lost or damaged items.

Laundry is done at camp once a week. Specialty riding gear will be laundered separately.
